Kittens rely on mom to care for them. Without mom these kittens need your help! Take them to your nearest shelter as soon as possible.

Yes



They need to stay with their mom. It is better and safer for them to stay with her. Once the kittens are walking on their own trap them and mom. Take the kittens to your local shelter and take mom to get spayed, vaccinated and return her to where you trapped her.

Yes



Take them to your nearest shelter, so they can get socialized and adopted into loving homes.

Are the kittens handleable?

Trying to grab them is difficult and dangerous for you and them. Get a humane cat trap.



Kittens 2 months and older can not be socialized, but they can live long and healthy lives if they get TRAPPED, NEUTERED, and RETURNED to where you trapped them.
