

Microchips

How do they work?



Microchips are very small, about the size of a grain of rice.



Microchips cannot be hacked. Their only function is to emit a series of numbers/letters when scanned.



Microchips are not a GPS system or a tracker.



The chip is implanted at a vet clinic, underneath the skin behind your cat's neck. It is not painful.



Microchips when scanned, do not show any personal information.

A series of numbers/letters show up which corresponds to a microchip company where your animal is registered at.



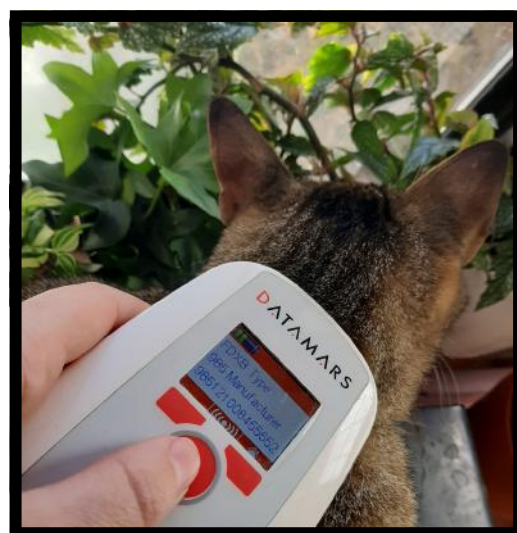
Only your contact information is registered with the chip number in an online database.



Microchips only work if you keep your information up-to-date.

If your cat ever gets lost, and is brought to a shelter or veterinary clinic, the staff will scan your cat for a chip and then look up your contact information.
