

How to use a feral cat trap.



A step-by-step guide with pictures.

1 Gather materials

- Trap
- Trap cover (towel or a sheet)
- Newspaper
- Bait (mackerel, tuna, sardines ect.)
- Spoon



2 Become familiar with the trap.



"Human door"

This is the door you use to set up the trap.



Door lock

Make sure this is always locked when in use or with a cat inside.



"Cat door"

This is the door the cat enters to get trapped.

3 Practice setting the trap.

Remember this helpful saying push-pull-set



Push

door in and grab back door



Pull

both doors up and hold doors to top of trap



Set

by holding doors to top of trap and pushing hook forward setting doors on top of gold piece

4 Get the trap ready for a cat



open the "human door" and take two sheets of newspaper and place them in the trap covering the whole bottom.

5 Bait the trap



Take your bait and place most of it near the "human door" on the newspaper. Take some liquid from your bait and spread it out in the trap making a trail from the "human door" to the "cat door".

6 Lock the trap and put on a trap cover



Always lock you trap!

7 Now set the trap and catch a cat!
